## From the Pastor's Desk

### **John the Baptist**

There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. John was filled with the Holy Spirit, even from his mother's womb, by Christ Himself, whom the Virgin Mary had just conceived by the Holy Spirit. Mary's visitation to Elizabeth thus became a visit from God to God's people.

John is Elijah who must come. The fire of the Spirit dwells in him and makes him the forerunner of the coming Lord. In John, the precursor, the Holy Spirit completes the work of making ready a people prepared for the Lord.

John the Baptist is more than a prophet. In him, the Holy Spirit concludes God's speaking through God's prophets. John completes the cycle of prophets begun by Elijah.

John proclaims the imminence of the consolation of Israel; he is the "voice" of the Consoler who is coming. As the Spirit of truth will also do, John came to bear witness to the light. In John's sight, the Spirit thus brings to completion the careful search of the prophets and fulfills the longing of the angels. "He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain, this is He who baptizes with the Holy Spirit. And I have seen and have borne witness that this is the Son of God...Behold the Lamb of God" (Jn 1:33-36).

Finally, with John the Baptist, the Holy Spirit begins the restoration to humankind of "the divine likeness," prefiguring what God would achieve with and in Christ. John's baptism was for repentance; baptism in water and the Spirit will be a new birth!

May we all join John the Baptist in announcing the birth of the Messiah, and the salvation of the world; marked by the birth of Our Savior this Christmas.

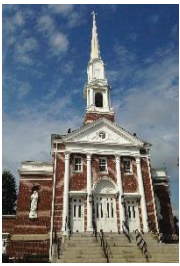
