## PASTOR'S LETTER

Of the three practices encouraged by the Church during Lent (prayer, fasting and almsgiving), I think it's safe to say we have the most trouble with fasting! Since we live in a land of plenty, the thought of fasting rarely crosses our minds. Worse, when it does, we just can't seem to find the strength to do it. Yet, fasting (not only from food, but from TV, the internet, video games, etc.) has amazing spiritual effects. Those who fast find great peace and strength in their daily effort to live rightly and avoid sin. Why is this so? A few reasons come to mind:

1. Fasting is penitential. We forgo good things as a way to express to God our sorrow for our sins. Such humility touches God very deeply.
2. Fasting reminds us that we don't need "things" to make us happy, rather we need God alone. Focusing on God helps us to tap into His love and strength.
3. Fasting is a building block in learning self-discipline, preparing us for greater sacrifices we will be called to make in the future.
4. Fasting is a way of expressing solidarity, individually and as a Church, with the poor of the world, the poor in whom Jesus says we will meet Him. While not easy for us Americans, fasting is a powerful fuel for spiritual growth. I pray you will fast from something every day.
5. Rice Bowls are available at the doors. Please take one and fill it with "alms" for the poor. Generous givers to the poor were always greatly blessed by God in the Scriptures. It is still so in our own day.

Finally, Daily Mass continues at 8:00 AM Monday to Thursday. Daily Mass is the BEST way to jump start your day—the benefits are truly amazing (ask any of our daily Mass-goers!!!). May you have a peaceful and holy Lent. Please be assured of my prayers for you throughout this blessed season of Lent. You'll be amazed at the results!!

**Lenten Guidelines.** Abstinence from meat on the **Fridays** of Lent (for those 14 and older) is required by Church law. Also, Good Friday is a day of **fasting**. Those between the ages of 18 and 59 should eat less, meaning, take no solid food between meals and only one full meal on those days.

Serious health conditions excuse a person from these precepts.

Parents are encouraged by Church law to ensure that minors who are not bound by the law of fast and abstinence are educated nonetheless in an authentic sense of penance.
