Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are a few days away from the beginning of Lent. Let this time of the Liturgical Year challenge us and strengthen our faith & commitment to live out the call of holiness, which is an invitation to all of us. As we enter this Season of Lent, we are mindful of what the Lord has taught us by His life: suffering, sacrifice, death and resurrection. Let us enter with a heart and mind open to the power of the Holy Spirit. We are baptized into Christ. In Baptism we are joined to the life of Christ. We enter His life, death, and resurrection. We truly participate in His life. Saint Paul shares this reality with us from his own experience, "I have been crucified with Christ; yet I live, no longer I, but Christ lives in me" (Galatians 2:20). Our faith is a relationship with the Person of Jesus Christ who gives us and guides us in all we do because He is "the way, the truth and the life" (cf. John 14:6). Let our Lenten observance assist us in growing closer to Christ and His Bride, the Church. In preparation for the Lenten Season please see the regulations offered on this page. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14th. The Mass schedule for Ash Wednesday is: Saint Joseph at 8 am and Saint Patrick at 7 pm. Ashes will be distributed at both Masses. *Note: the Bishop will not offer any dispensation on Ash Wednesday.*

Stations of the Cross will be held on Friday nights during Lent at 7 pm. The location of the stations will rotate. On Friday, February 16 stations will be prayed at Saint Joseph. The following week, February 23 at Saint Patrick, etc.

A Lenten Mission will be offered the first week of March. More information to come.

Please keep in prayer all those who are in the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults). There are 7 adults who will be receiving or completing their Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation & First Communion). There is one child who will be making her First Holy Communion. This is going to be a great community celebration at the Easter Vigil.

### Lenten Fast & Abstinence Regulations

**Abstinence** from meat on Ash Wednesday (February 14) and the Fridays of Lent (for those 14 and older) is required by Church law. Also, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting: those between the ages of 18 and 59 should eat less (meaning take no solid food between meals and only one full meal that day). Serious health conditions excuse a person from these precepts. Minors who are not bound by the law of fast and abstinence should nonetheless be educated in an authentic sense of penance.

**NOTE:** For Valentine’s Day (2/14), dispensations from the discipline of fasting and abstinence will not be granted by the Bishop.
