PASTOR'S PAGE



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are a week and a half away from the beginning of the Season of Lent. What is God calling you to give up this year? What is God calling you to include this year into your daily

routine? In other words, what do I need to sacrifice (give up) or do to become closer to Jesus, who is my Lord and my God? This season of the Church invites us into deeper intimacy with Christ. He is our Savior and Redeemer. He is the One who breaks the chains of sin and death which holds us back from true freedom. Let us live more in the freedom of Christ's passion, death and resurrection. May this Lenten journey help us to turn from sin and live virtuous and holy lives for the glory of God.

Both offices will be closed in honor of the Presidents' Day Holiday on February 17th. Many prayers to all who are traveling this holiday weekend.

BINGO will be held on Friday, February 21st. Must be 18 years or older to play. Doors open at 5 pm. Games start at 6 pm. Food will be available for purchase. All proceeds will help defray the cost of our group attending the Steubenville East Youth Conference in July.

Two projects have been completed, one at each church, from the money received from the Diocesan Campaign. Each quarter, each parish will receive a check of the 40% raised during that quarter. That money is directed towards the specified projects at each parish. Thank you all again for your generosity and continued support and prayers. As you all know, taking care of any structure is an ongoing project.

Looking Ahead: Lent ...Ash Wednesday –February 26th: Masses (with distribution of ashes) at 8 AM Saint Patrick Church, & 7 PM Saint Joseph Church. Stations of the Cross are prayed on Friday Nights at 7 pm beginning on February 28th at Saint Joseph Church; then alternating location every Friday.

All-day confessions are scheduled for Saturday, April 4th from 8:30 AM to 3 PM at Saint Philip Church, Greenville. Confessions are offered at Saint Patrick Church every Saturday from 3:15 PM to 3:45 PM or by appointment. Lenten regulation reminders: Abstinence from meat and meat products is required of all those 14 years old and over on Ash Wednesday (February 26) and all the Fridays of Lent (February 28, March 6, March 13, March 20, March 27, April 3). Fasting is required of those between the ages of 18 and 59 on Ash Wednesday (February 26) and Good Friday (April 10), but is a good practice of self-control and self-denial on any day of Lent, especially on Fridays when we commemorate in a particular way the Lord's Passion and Death for us on the Cross. Fasting means no eating between meals; eating only one full meal; trying to eat less.

"Let our focus be not on ourselves, but on Jesus" every day of our lives, especially during Lent. "Let us turn toward Jesus Christ and beg for a renewed experience of his presence. He is the one who saves me from my miserable condition; it is his merciful gaze that awakens and transforms me." Amen.
