

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In preparation for Lent, the Mass schedule for Ash Wednesday on February 26th will be offered at 8 AM

at Saint Patrick Church and 7 PM at Saint Joseph Church. Ashes will be imposed during these Masses. Abstinence from meat and meat products is required of all those 14 years old and over on Ash Wednesday (February 26) and all the Fridays of Lent (February 28, March 6, March 13, March 20, March 27, April 3). Fasting is required of those between the ages of 18 and 59 on Ash Wednesday (February 26) and Good Friday (April 10), but is a good practice of selfcontrol and self-denial on any day of Lent, especially on Fridays when we commemorate in a particular way the Lord's Passion and Death for us on the Cross. Fasting means no eating between meals; eating only one full meal; trying to eat less. May our Lenten journey help us to turn our whole life back to God, through His Son, Jesus Christ.

All Day confessions are scheduled for Saturday, April 4th from 8:30 AM to 3 PM at Saint Philip Church in Greenville.

A huge thank you to all who volunteered and participated in the BINGO fundraiser. This fundraiser will support and help defray the cost of our youth attending the Steubenville conference at URI in July. Please keep this group and all who will participate in this conference in prayer.

The quarterly parish share checks have been received by both parishes. As part of the Grateful for God's Providence Campaign, each parish in the diocese receives 40% of the money raised toward the goal. Thank you for your continued financial and prayerful support to the Diocese and our parishes. We receive a parish share check every quarter.
