How To Make A Good Confession

- 1. Go into the Reconciliation Room, you may kneel behind the screen or sit facing the priest.
- 2. You make the sign of the cross and say: "Bless me Father, for I have sinned, this is (my first confession) OR it has been (how many weeks, months or years) since my last confession and these are my sins..."
- 3. You confess your sins.
- 4. You listen to what guidance the priest gives you.
- 5. The priest gives you your penance.
- 6. You say the Act of Contrition out loud for the priest.
- 7. Absolution: the priest raises his right hand and forgives your sins.
- 8. You say, "Thanks be to God".
- 9. Exit the Reconciliation Room and kneel at the altar railing or in your pew and pray your penance.

*Remember to speak loud enough for the priest to hear you and please do not forget to thank God for forgiving your sins.

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended You. And I detest all my sins, because they offend You, my God. Who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of your Grace, to sin no more. And to avoid whatever leads me to sin. AMEN.
