Dear Brothers and Sisters,

What must we do to inherit eternal life? Jesus answers this question with a question to the scholar. The scholar reveals his understanding:

*"You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself." (Luke 10:27)*

Jesus confirms his understanding. What is our understanding of inheriting eternal life? Can we answer in a similar way as the scholar did? The Commandments are summed up as a way to love God and neighbor. The first 3 tell us how we love God. The last 7 tell us how we love our neighbor. Let the lessons we receive from the Word of God strengthen us in our resolve to inherit eternal life.

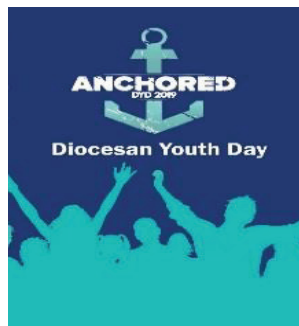
