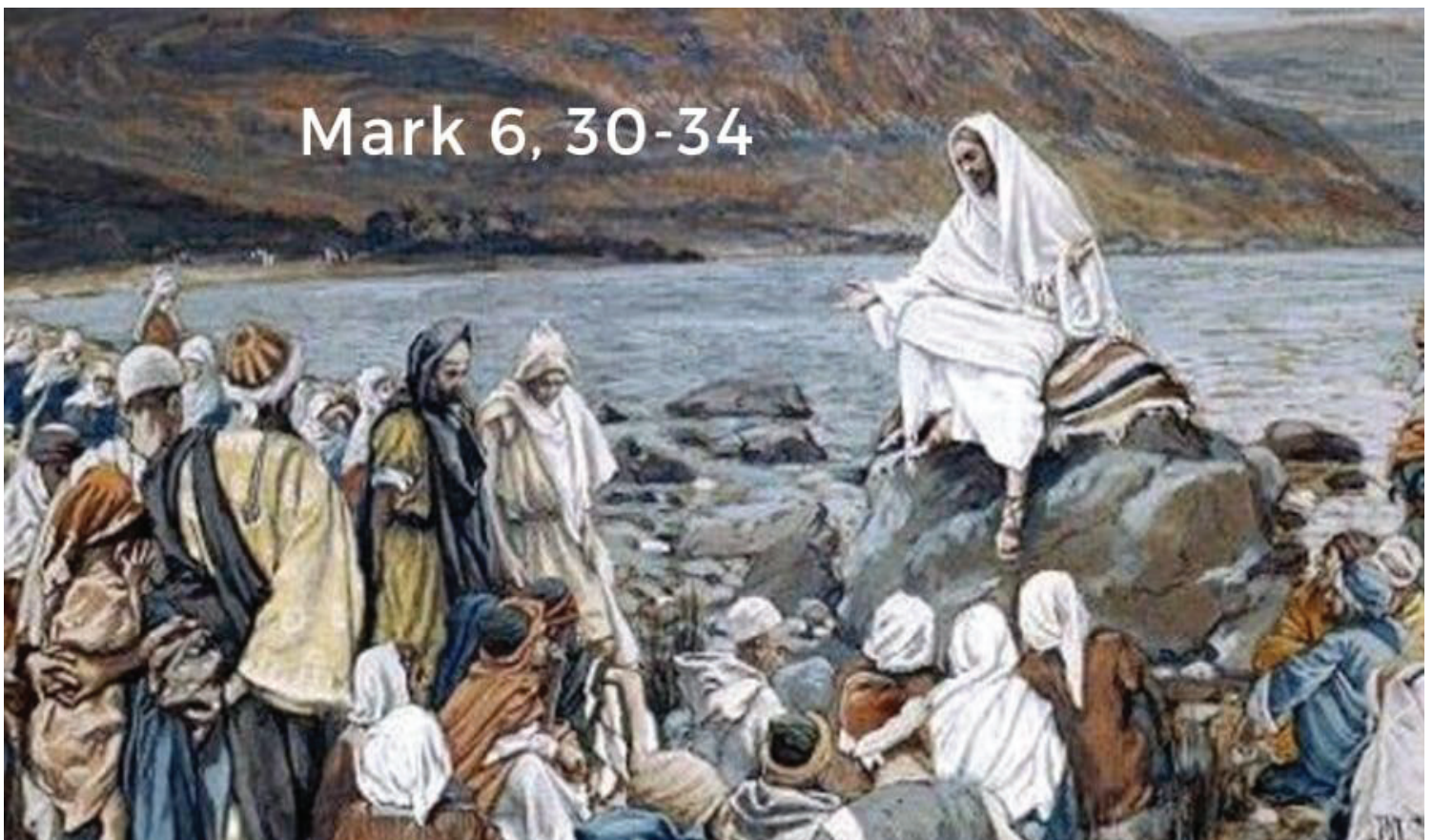

If you choose, you may deposit cash in an envelope with your parish’s name clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Such envelopes will be treated as budget envelopes.
