Dear Friends in Christ,

In the Gospel of Matthew, chapter 13, the Lord continues to speak to us about the Kingdom of Heaven. We have been listening to the Gospel of Matthew, chapter 13, for the last few Sundays. We are learning about the Kingdom of Heaven through the use of parables. How have these parables been impacting our thoughts about the Kingdom of Heaven? How have the last few months been impacting our thoughts about the Kingdom of Heaven?

As we focus on the Kingdom of Heaven, may it help us on our journey of faith. We are called to a higher place. We are made and called to live with God forever in His Kingdom. We are called to build His Kingdom. We are invited to encounter Christ, who reveals to us the Kingdom of our Heavenly Father. Let us ask the Holy Spirit to guide us and deepen our awareness of the Kingdom of Heaven.

With the Kingdom of Heaven in mind, let us turn even more closely to what the Lord is trying to reveal to us. When the Lord talks about the Kingdom, it is close. The parables each have their own example of closeness. Ultimately, the Lord wants us to know Him and to live as He teaches us to live, in peace, joy, love and hope. In the section on Christian Prayer, in the Catechism of the Catholic Church, the ultimate prayer is the prayer Jesus taught us, the "Our Father". In this prayer, Jesus prays: "Thy Kingdom Come". The Catechism states in this section, "The Kingdom of God lies ahead of us. It is brought near in the Word incarnate, it is proclaimed throughout the whole Gospel, and it has come in Christ's death and Resurrection. The Kingdom of God has been coming since the Last Supper and, in the Eucharist, it is in our midst" (2816). Saint Cyprian states: "...the Kingdom of God means Christ himself, who we daily desire to come, and whose coming we wish

to be manifested quickly to us. For as he is our resurrection, since in him we rise, so he can also be understood as the Kingdom of God, for in him we shall reign."

All parables point to Christ. He is the Way, the Truth and the Life (cf. John 14:6). May we continue to grow as His disciples. Discipleship is letting everything else go so as to find the "pearl of great price", Jesus Christ. In Him, we move, we live and have our being. Let us continue to build His Kingdom and prepare ourselves, with His grace, to meet Him face to face.




In this time of trial and testing, teach all of us in the Church to love one another and to be patient and kind. Help us to bring the peace of Jesus to our land and to our hearts.
