Dear Friends in Christ,

Prayers and blessings to all of you on this Sunday and Father's Day weekend. Blessings and prayers to all our fathers--living and deceased.

The month of June is filled with graduations, ordinations, family gatherings, anticipation of summer and vacations. By the way, one of my favorite parts of this time of year in RI is the Newport Creamery Monday Special buy one Awful Awful and get one free! All these are signs of God's mighty gifts and blessings. This is a good time as well to notice how we have grown in knowledge, service and wisdom.
