**KING OF THE UNIVERSE**



Christ the King Sunday is a Christian feast day that celebrates Jesus Christ's kingship over the universe. It

takes place on the last Sunday of the liturgical year, right before Advent.

The feast was established in 1925 by Pope Pius XI in response to the growing secularism and atheism of the time. It was originally celebrated on the last Sunday of October, but was moved to the last Sunday of Ordinary Time in 1969.

The feast emphasizes that Christ's kingship is eternal, while governments come and go. It's a reminder that Christians should acknowledge Christ's kingship in their lives by: Submitting to revealed truths and Christ's doctrines and Obeying God's laws and precepts.

Some ways to observe Christ the King Sunday include:

- Reflecting on how Christ's commands can help people focus on those he held closest, such as widows, orphans, and the disabled
- Considering how the world is different from the kingdom of God, and how Christians can use their power and privilege to make Christ manifest in their lives
- Revering and emulating Jesus' leadership by loving and seeking justice for all people
