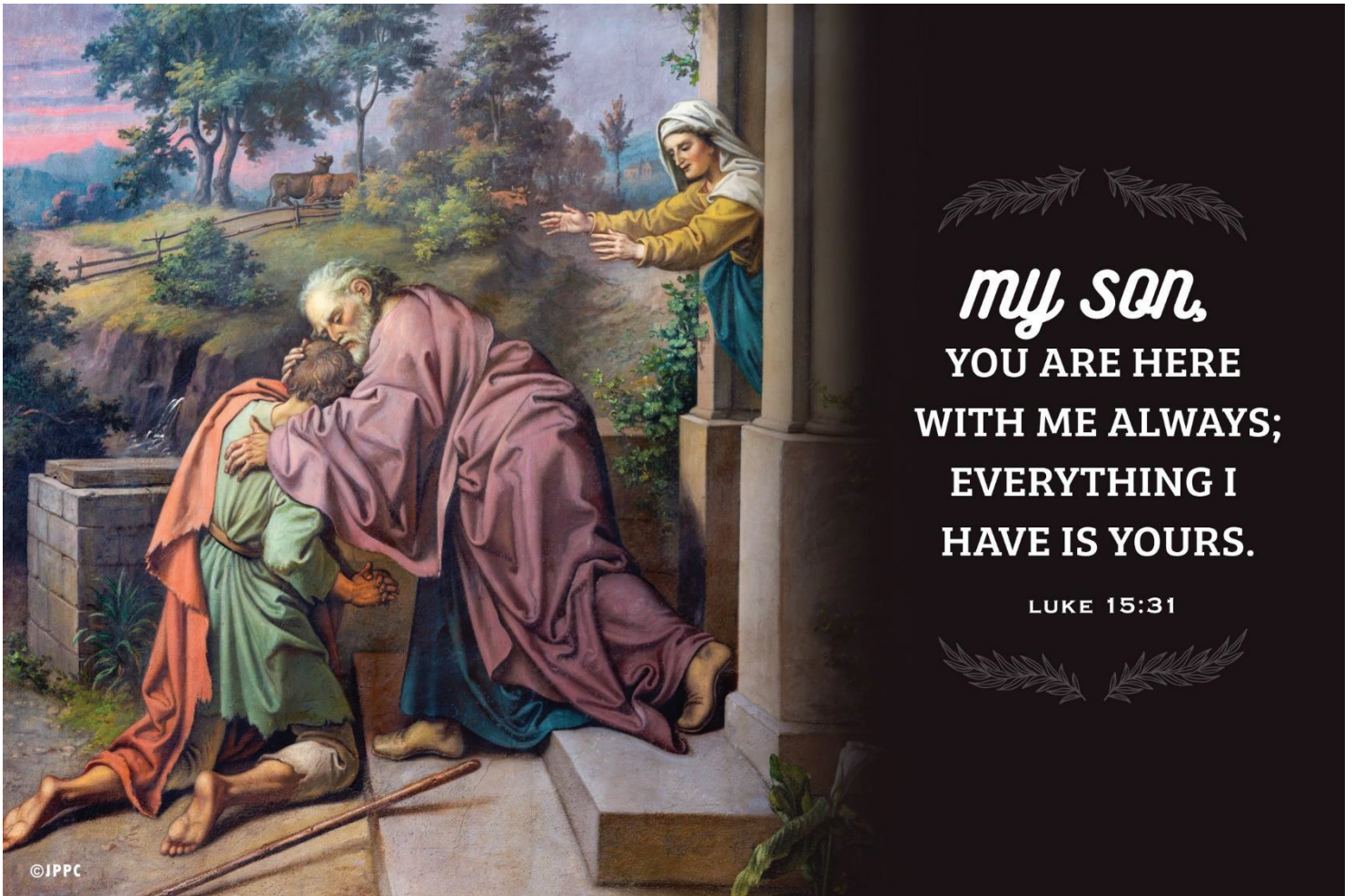

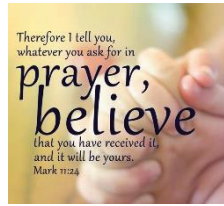

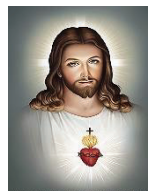
BUDGET ENVELOPES
