Annual Notice re: Property Insurance Value

Waiver – This Waiver allows the Agreed Upon Value of our School/Convent to remain \$750,000. Quarterly insurance payments were reduced from \$3,607.34 to \$683.63. The Agreed Upon Value of the Rectory/Garage remains \$400,000. Quarterly insurance payments were reduced from \$657.33 to \$364.60. Total savings per quarter for the School/Convent & Rectory/Garage are \$3,216.44. The value of the Church is the Full Replacement Value of the building, which remains \$4,646,074.
